Snapshots in Life: Someone you know.

Choose three time periods. The time periods can be any span of years. Some suggestions: Baby years, Elementary school, middle school, High school, college, young adult.

You will need to interview the person and ask the following questions for each of the time periods.

Questions to ask:

1. What was the person like during this time?

2. Where did this person live?
3. What did he/she like to do?
4. Where did he/she go to school or work?
5. What were his/her dreams/goals at this time?

Remember you are writing a story about this person. Have fun with this!

You will need to find at least one picture from each period (you will need the pictures in Module 3, so don't worry about it quite yet)

Snapshots in Time - Technology Current Events

Technology around the globe is changing at an extremely fast pace. To keep abreast of the ever-changing new technology that is being introduced daily you can research current event technology topics.

You will use your research later on when you build a Web site beginning in the next module. In Module 1 we are going to ask you to research three current events that are related to technology.

Research an article about a new technology or a technological advancement that is interesting to you. Select an article where it is easy to identify the technological component both quickly and easily.

1. Visit one of the suggested Web sites below, or use any site of your choice.
2. READ the article.
3. The format you will follow for the current events is shown below.
 - a. What is the title of this article?
 - b. When did you find this on the internet?
 - c. What is the full URL (web site address) of this article?
 - d. In your own words, write at least a three sentence paragraph summary of the article. Please DO NOT COPY AND PASTE any part of the article. We need to make sure that your work is copyright compliant! In your paragraph explain WHO, WHAT, WHERE, and WHEN as it pertains to your topic.
 - e. Paragraph 2 - Now you will write another three or more sentence paragraph. This is where you need to give your opinion about the

technology. WHY are you interested in this technology? Will this technology help change the world for the better? WHY or WHY not?

Is there an image of this new technology? If there is an image depicting this new technology, please save it inside the images folder.
