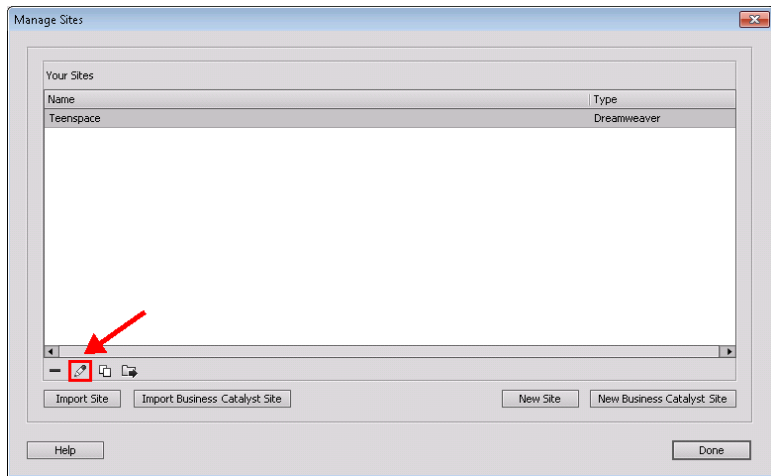


First, you will want to delete the files that you previously uploaded, since they are in an incorrect location.

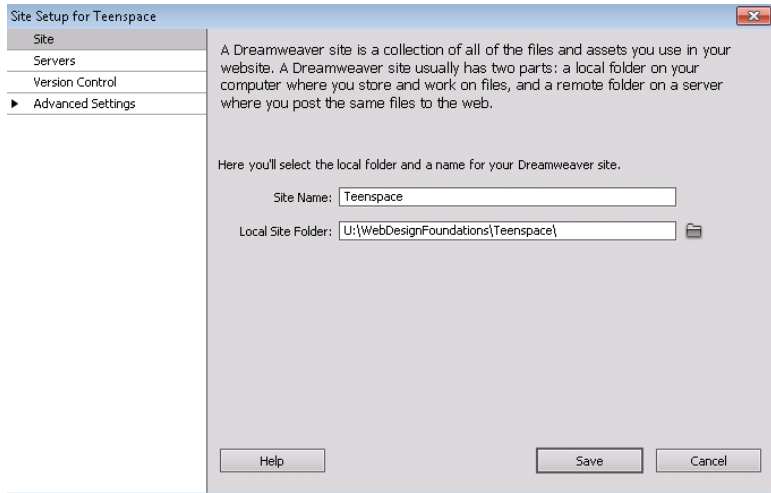
Open Dreamweaver and Select **SITE > MANAGE SITES**. Import your Teenspace Site and press the **EDIT** button (looks like a pencil)



Check that your folders are set correctly.

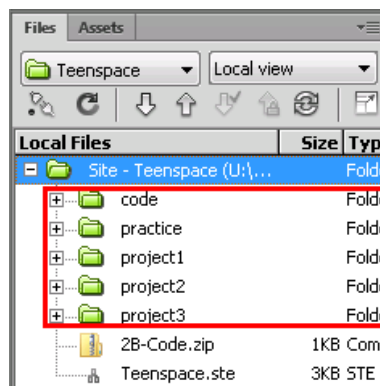
The Local Site Folder should say: **U:\WebDesignFoundations\Teenspace**

It should NOT have the project1 folder listed.

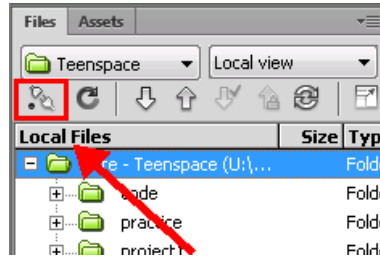


Press Done to close the Manage Sites box.

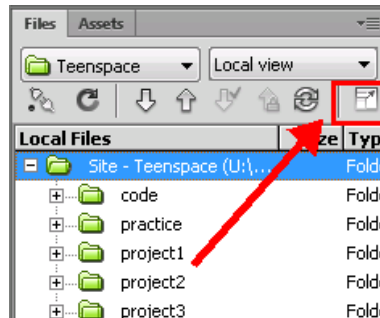
Look in the Files Panel. You should see all of the folders you'll be using in this class.



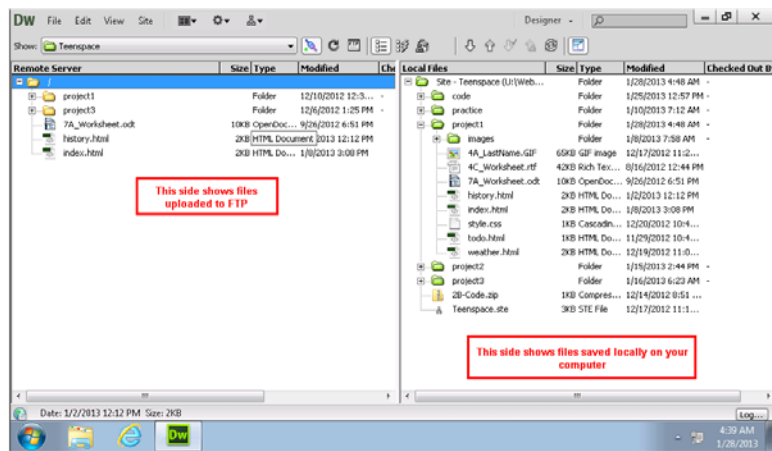
Connect to the FTP by pressing the “Connect to Remote Server” icon.



Let’s take a look at the files you have uploaded. Press the “Expand to show local and remote site” icon.



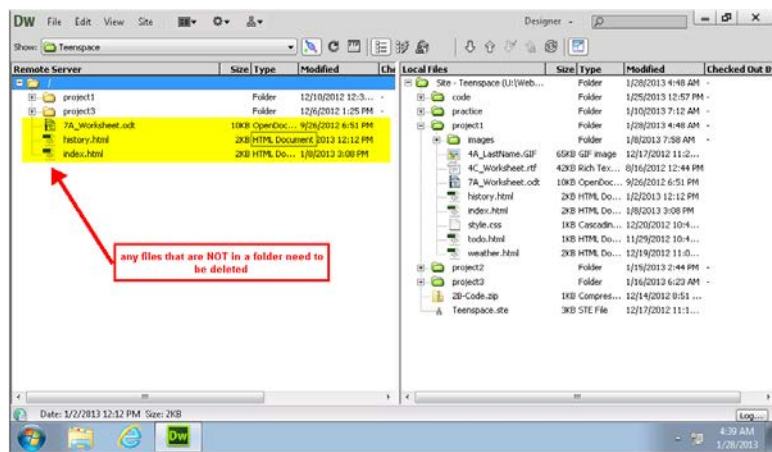
The screen displays files saved on the FTP and files saved locally on your computer.



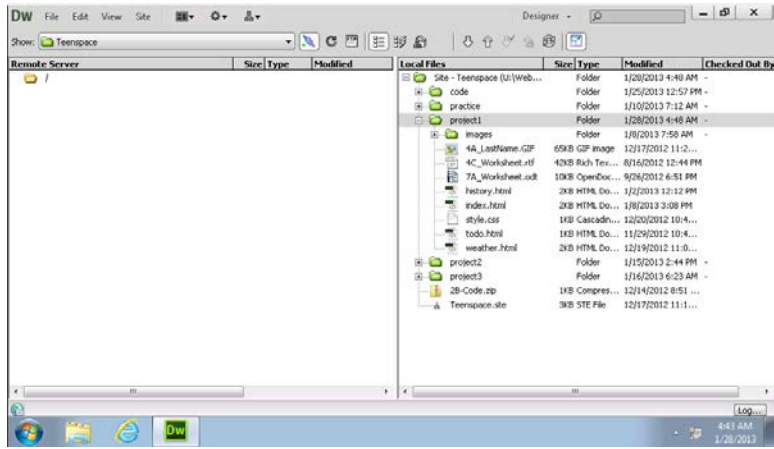
The files on the left side are the ones you have successfully uploaded to the FTP.

Let’s remove the files that are on the FTP now and start fresh. Delete all of the files on the LEFT side of your screen.

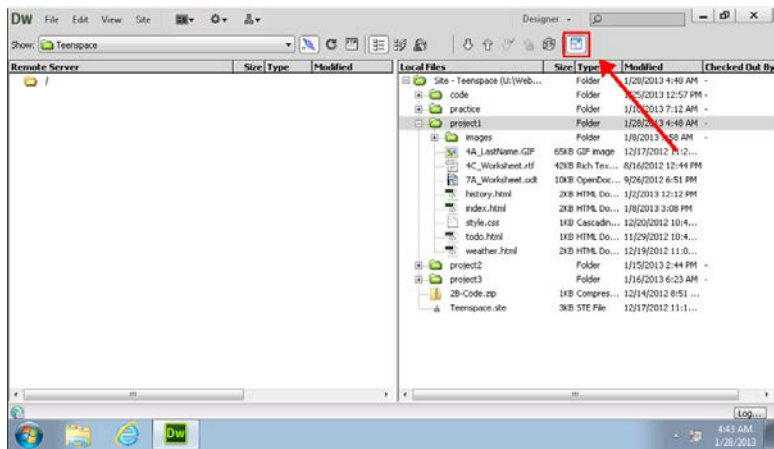
NOTE: As long as you are only deleting the files on the LEFT side of the screen, you are only taking the files down from the FTP and not deleting your work.



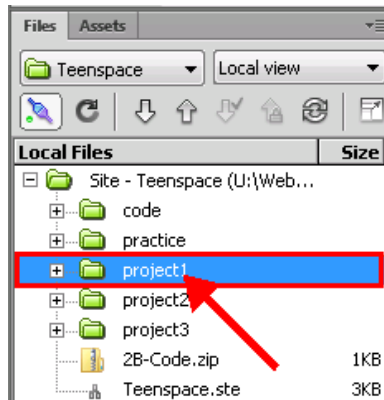
Your screen should look something like this one:



Press the "Collapse to show only local site" icon

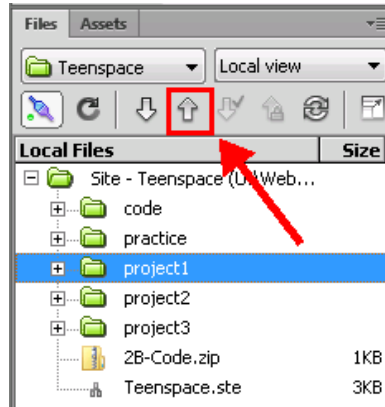


In the Files Panel, select the Project 1 folder.

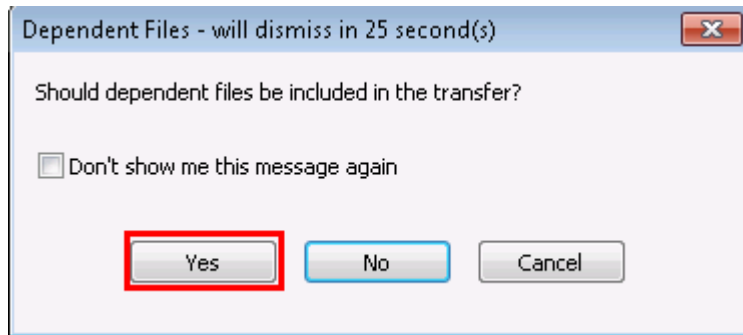


With the project1 folder selected, press the “PUT” icon (looks like an up arrow) to put the folder up on the server.

When you upload your future files, you will PUT the folder up that you want uploaded.



If you get a pop-up about dependent files, select YES.



Open your web browser. Go to this address:
